Thursday 21st

Commences with a fine breeze from the
S E ship under all sail steering W by N
Middle & latter part much the same
To Ends this day Lat 7.15 Lon 97.51

Friday 22nd

Commences with a light breeze from the
S E ship under all plain sail. Steering
W by N, middle & latter part much the
same men employed at ships duty
To Ends this day Lat 6.15 Lon 99.45

Saturday 23rd

Commences with a light breeze from
the S E ship under all sail. steering
W by N, men employed at ships duty
Middle & latter part the same. To
Ends this day Lat 5.28 Lon 102.46

Sunday 24th

Commences with a light breeze from
the S E ship under all sail. steering
W by N, middle & latter part much
the same & so end this day

Lat 4.41 Lon 105.29

Monday 25th

Commence with a light breeze from
the S E ship under all sail steering W
by N middle & latter part the same
Men employed at coopersing & stowing
Down Oil To end

Lat 4.32 Lon 108.09

Bound on a whale voyage to the Arctic Ocean
Tuesday Feb 26th

Commences with a light breeze from the
S E ship under all sail steering W by N
Middle & latter part the same men
Employed at ships duty To end this day
Lat 4.50 Lon 110.33

Wednesday 27th

Commences with a strong breeze from
the S E ship under all sail. steering
W by N middle & latter part the same
To End Lat 4.52

Thursday 28th

Commences with a light breeze from
the S E ship under all sail. steering
W by N at 5 a m saw a shoal of
Sperm whales & lowered two boats
to chase whales going quick to
windward give them up for the night.
Ship on opposite tack steering the
night at 9 o'clock P m raise them
again to windward going quick ship.
On opposite tack To Ends

Friday 29th

Commences with a strong breeze
from the S E ship on opposite tack
In chase of a shoal of Sperm whales
at 3 o'clock lower two boats in chase whales
going quick to the windward at dark came
On board middle & latter part ship still
Beating To ends Lat 4.55 Lon 114.41
