Friday April 5th

Commence with light N.E. wind Ship steering west
Middle part wind variable latter part calm
To the north & remains steady the remainder
of the day Lat 22.25

Saturday 6th

Commence with a light breeze from the
N.E. Ship under all sail steering west watch
Employed repairing the mainsail middle
& latter part strong So end this day
Lat 22.33. Lon 168.12

Sunday 7th

Commence with a fine breeze from the N.E.
Ship under all sail steering west middle
part the same latter part quite light So
End this day Lat 22.51 Lon 167.04

Monday 8th

Commence with a light breeze from the N.E.
Ship in the starboard tack steering West middle
part variable latter part calm So End
Lat 23.33

Tuesday 9th

Commence with a light breeze from the south
Ship under all sail steering W. by S middle
part strong breeze from the N.E. with
much rain latter part calm to the north
Quite light So end Lat 22.52 Lon 170.32

Wednesday 10th

Commence with a light breeze from the
N.E. Ship under all sail steering W. by S
middle part the same latter part light
So End
Lat 23.07

Thursday April 11th

Commence with a light breeze from the N.E.
Ship under all sail steering West middle & latter
part much the same So end this day
Lat 23.23, Lon 169.29

Friday 12th

Commence with a light breeze from the N.E. Ship
Under all sail steering W. by N. middle &
latter part much the same So
End this day Lat 23.56 Lon 171.14

Saturday 13th

Commence with a strong breeze from the N.E.
Ship under all sail steering W. by N. middle
& latter part squally with rain men employed
At Ship dydy work Lat 25.00 Lon 178.42 W

Sunday 14th

Commence with a strong breeze from the N.E. Ship under
all sail steering W. by N. at 5. & M double reef
the topsails & haul up to N.W. by N latter
part quite light breeze from the East So end
Lat 26.57 Lon 179.42 East

Monday 15th

Commence with a light breeze from the eastward
Ship under all sail steering N.W. by N middle
part the wind calm to the S.E. very light latter part
the same So end Lat 28.28 Lon 179.52 E

Tuesday 16th

Commence with a light breeze from the S.E. Ship
under all sail steering N.W. by N middle part
the same latter part wind calm to the
north & breeze an double reef the topsails
Raising & thick So end
