Remarks on board of ship Tho Dickason

Wednesday 17th

Commences with a strong breeze from the North ship under double reef topsails & courses steering N.W. middle part the same latter part wind cuts to the N.E. & moderates make all sail so end
Lat 31.35 Lon 176.24

Thursday 18th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship under all sail steering N.W. middle part wind cuts to the S.E. latter part thick & rainy wind hauling to the westward so ends this day No Observations

Friday 19th

Commences with a strong S.W. wind. Ship under all sail. Steering N.W. middle part light cuts back to the S.E. latter part cuts to the N.E. with much rain & squally take in the light sail so ends this day No Observations

Saturday 20th

Commences with a strong N.E. wind ship under double reef topsails & courses steering N.W. middle part light & cuts to the north latter part make all sail so end Lat 37.33

Sunday 21st

This day begins with a fine breeze from the North ship under all sail steering N.W. middle part wind cuts to the N.W. latter part hauls back to the South so end Lat 38.54 Lon 176.42

Monday 22nd

Commences with a strong breeze from the South ship under all sail steering N.W. by N. middle & latter part thick & rainy so end

Tuesday 23rd

Commences with a strong breeze from the South. Ship under all sail steering N.W. by N. middle part thick fog. latter blows on to a gale & cuts to the westward. Ship under double reef main topsail fore course & staysails heading N. by W. so ends this day Lat 44.01

Wednesday 24th

Commences with a gale from the N.W. ship under D Reef Main topsail fore course & staysails middle part the same latter part more moderate ship under double reef topsails & courses so ends Lat 45.30 Lon 169.02

Thursday 25th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. ship under Double reef topsails heading N. by E middle part give her the mainsail & job latter part blows on put her under close sail so ends No Observations

Friday 26th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. ship under D.R. M. topsail & foresail middle part the same latter part under double reef topsails so end Lat 48.40 Lon 169.23

Saturday 27th

Commences with a strong breeze from westward ship under double reef topsails & courses steering N.W. middle part cuts to the east quite light latter part wind N.E. ship under all sail so ends Lat 49.50 Lon 168.39

Sunday 28th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. ship under all sail steering N.W. middle part breezes on take in the light sails mainsail & job latter part must be same
