Remarks on board of ship The Fish Hawk

Thursday 23rd May

Commenced with a fine breeze from N.W. ship
under D.R. topsails on opposite tack sailing
middle part moderates & came to the South
latter part blow and so ends

Friday 24th

Commenced with a strong breeze from the South
ship under D.R. topsails working through the
ice at 9 AM saw and whale lowered the
boat & the Bow Boat struck & captured
the gentleman latter part out. hind in
so ends

Sat 6.2.15

Saturday 25th

Commenced with a strong breeze from the
North ship cutting the whale middle &
latter part match the same so ends

Sunday 26th

Commenced with a strong breeze from the
North ship under D.R. topsails on
Opposite working to the N.E. latter
part sailing wind coming to the
Westward so ends Sat 6.2.15

Monday 27th

Commenced with a strong breeze from the
N.W. ship under D.R. topsails & staysails
On the Starboard tack heading N. by E
sailing middle & latter part the
same so ends Sat 6.2.35 N

Tuesday 28th

Commenced with a strong breeze from
the N.W. ship on opposite tack working
to the North through build ice latter
part light breeze so ends

Sat 6.0.32 Low 179.03 E

Wind on a Whall boag in the ice

Wednesday 29th May

Commenced with a light breeze from the N.W. ship
on opposite tack middle part wind came
to the Westward commenced stowing down
latter part the same

Thursday 30th

Commenced with a light breeze from the N.W. ship on
Opposite tack stowing down oil latter part
sawing quite strong so ends

Friday 31st

Commenced with a light breeze from the
Westward all hands employed stowing
oil middle part sawing the watch
Employed scraping Bow latter part
the same so ends Sat 6.2.

Saturday June 1st

Commenced with a light breeze from the
N.W. ship under topsails & jibs on
Opposite tack working to the North
middle & latter part saw sawing
so ends

Sunday 2nd

Commenced with a strong breeze from
the Westward ship on opposite tack working
to the North latter part light spoke
the boat sparth so ends

Monday 3rd

Commenced with a light breeze from the
Westward ship under all sail working
to the North middle & latter part
the same so ends
