Remarks on Board of Ship Tho Dickerson

Tuesday June 4th
Commences with a light breeze from the
N.W. ship under all sail steering to the
northward middle & latter part much
the same with quite a number of
ships in sight do end

Sat 61.37

Wednesday 5th
Commences with a light breeze from the
West ship under all sail steering to
the north with the land in sight
& nine vessels all working to the N.W.
latter part calm do end

Sat 61.33

Thursday 6th
Commences with a light breeze from
the N.E. ship under all sail working to
the north middle & latter part calm
do end this day

Friday 7th
Commences with fine weather & a light
breeze from the North ship and opposite
tack middle part calm latter part
much the same do end

Sat 62.17

Saturday 8th
Commences with calm weather Cape
Shaddins bearing N. N. E. middle
part get a breeze from the N. E.
latter part the same shake two
brigs the Victoria & Rakola do end

Sunday 9th
Commences with a fair breeze from
the N. E. ship under all sail running
to the eastward middle part
wind came to the westward
do end

Bound on a whaling voyage in the ice

Monday June 10th
Commences with a light breeze from the N. E.
Ship under all sail on opposite tack with
steering to in sight middle part wind came
to the westward & breeze on latter part the
same with 6 sail in sight do end this day

Tuesday 11th
Commences with a strong breeze from the westward
ship under the sails & jibs on opposite tack with
Cape Shaddins bearing N. by E latter part wind
came to the N. W. & breeze on double reef the
sails do end

Wednesday 12th
Commences with a strong breeze from the S. S. W.
Ship under D. R. topsail & stay sail middle part
the same latter part wind came to the S. W.
& breeze on close reef the S. & M. topsails &
do end this day

Thursday 13th
Commences with a strong breeze from the
S. W. ship under D. R. topsail middle & latter
part foggy do end

Friday 14th
Commences with a strong breeze from the South
Ship under D. R. topsails & jibs on opposite tack
Middle & latter part Cloudy wind came to
the Eastward do end

Saturday 15th
Commences with a strong breeze from the
Eastward ship under D. R. topsails steering
North middle part the same latter
part wind came to the North & moderated
do end
