Remarks On board of Ship. The Dickson
 Wednesday July 10th
 Commences with a light breeze from
 the S E Ship under all sail on opposite
 tacks with a thick fog middle & latter
 part much the same So ends
 Lat 69.02

Thursday 11th
 Commence with a strong breeze from the S E Ship
 under S R topsails & staysail heading E. N E middle
 part foggy latter part smoky saw considerable ice
 with Walrusen in it lowered three boat caught six
 of them & one Polar Bear So ends this day

Friday 12th
 Commence with a strong breeze from the S E Ship
 under S R topsails & staysail on opposite
 tacks middle & latter part foggy So ends

Saturday 13th
 Commences with a strong breeze from the S E
 Ship under S R topsails & staysail
 on opposite tacks middle & latter part
 thick fog So ends

Sunday 14th
 Commence with a strong breeze from
 the S E Ship under S R topsails & staysail
 on opposite tacks middle & latter part light
 breeze So ends Still foggy

Monday 15th
 Commences with a strong breeze from the
 S E Ship under S R topsails & staysail on
 opposite tacks middle part breeze on close reef
 the fore & Mizzen topsails latter part saw
 Land Bearing S E call it Cape Lisburn
 So ends this day

Bound on a whaling voyage in the Arctic
 Tuesday 16th
 Commences with a strong breeze from the S E Ship on
 opposite tacks working to the Eastward middle &
 latter part much the same So ends this day

Wednesday 17th
 Commences with a light breeze from the S E Ship
 under all sail on opposite tacks working to the
 S E middle part wind came to North West S E
 until we came up to heavy ice Cape Lisburn 20
 distant So ends
 Lat 69.15

Thursday 18th
 Commences with a light breeze from the S E Ship
 under all sail steering S W by W, ice compass
 middle part the same latter part strong breeze
 with Rain S R the topsail So ends

Friday 19th
 Commences with a strong breeze from the Eastward Ship
 under S R topsails & staysails middle part saw six barrel
 wind came to the S W & comes in foggy latter part wind
 came to west So ends

Saturday 20th
 Commence with a light westerly wind & thick weather
 Ship under topsails & jibs on opposite tacks with light
 ice in sight & a number of sails in sight middle part
 the breeze freshens S R the topsail & sets in rain
 So ends

Sunday 21st
 Commences with a strong breeze from the westward Ship
 under S R topsails & jibs middle part steering
 E. N E middle & latter part the same So ends
 this day
