Remarks on board of Ship The Dickson
Monday 22nd

Commences with a strong breeze from the
N^W ship under D^R topsails & jib
steering E^NE middle & latter part the
same so ends this day

Tuesday 23rd
Commences with a strong breeze from the
North ship under D^R topsail & staysail
with Close Reef bearing North middle part
blows on close reef main topsail & staysails
latter part set the main topsail two sail
in sight so ends

Wednesday 24th
Commences with a light gale from the North
ship under close reef W topsail & staysails laying
on opposite tacks middle part moderates latter
part wind cuts to the S^W make all sail
& steer North so ends

Thursday 25th
Commences with a strong breeze from the S^W
ship under all sail steering North middle part strong
breeze & foggy stand off shore under D^R topsails
latter stand in shore so ends this day

Friday 26th
Commences with a strong breeze from the N^W
ship on the starboard tack under D^R topsails
middle & latter part the same so ends

Saturday 27th
Commences with a strong breeze from the
N^W ship under D^R topsails on the starboard
tack heading W^SW middle part thick
latter part tack ship saw three vessels
steering to the North so ends

Bound on a Whaling voyage in the Arctic Ocean
Sunday 28th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N^W ship under D^R topsails
& staysails on opposite tacks working to the North middle
part foggy latter part light breeze so ends

Monday 29th
Commences with a light breeze from the N^W ship under
D^R topsail & staysails on the starboard tack heading
N^SE middle part wind cuts to the westward
latter part squally with snow so ends this day

Tuesday 30th
Commences with a strong breeze & thick weather ship
under D^R topsails & staysails on opposite tacks
working to the North middle part wind cuts
to the westward ship steering East so ends

Wednesday 31st
Commences with a strong breeze from the N^W ship under
topsails & plain sail heading to the E^NE middle
part the same latter part wind cuts to south
stand up to the land & tack ship so ends
this day

Thursday August 1st
Commences with a strong breeze from the North ship under
all sail steering S^W middle part laying a back
latter part keep her off again so ends this day

Friday 2nd
Commences with a strong breeze from the North
ship under all sail on the starboard tack heading
East middle part thick latter part cald so ends

Saturday 3rd
Commences with a strong breeze from the South
ship under all sail steering N^SE middle part
steering East latter part Cape Lisburn in
sight bearing E^SE ship Reindeer in sight
steering to the Northward so ends
