Remarks on board of Ship *Sho Dickason*
Wednesday August 28th
Commences with a strong breeze from the
N.E. Ship under D.R. topsails & staysails on
opposite tacks middle & latter part Foggy
So End

Thursday 29th
Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. Ship
under D.R. topsails & staysails on opposite tacks latter
part breezes on with thick weather & rain So
Ends this day

Friday 30th
Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. Ship
on opposite tacks under D.R. topsails & staysails
Middle & latter part much the same So
Ends this day

Saturday 31st
Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E.
Ship under D.R. topsails & staysails on opposite
tacks latter part Foggy with rain So ends this
day

Sunday Sept 1st
Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E.
Ship under D.R. topsails jibs & staysails
on opposite tacks middle & latter part thick foggy
So ends the day

Monday 2nd
Commences with a light breeze from the North
& a thick foggy Ship under D.R. topsails & staysails
middle part wind came to the westward & clear
off Ship Steering S.E. So ends

Tuesday 3rd
Commenced with a light wind from the N.W. Ship under
double reefed topsail middle and latter part strong wind
saw one whale and covered without success So ends

Bound on a whaling voyage to the Arctic Ocean

Wednesday Sept 4th
Commences with a strong breeze from the South
Ship under D.R. topsails & staysails with a
number of ships in sight middle part blow
on latter part blowing a gale Ship under
close reef main topsail & staysails So ends

Thursday 5th
Commences with a gale of wind from the South Ship under
close reef main topsail & staysails on opposite tacks
middle part moderate latter part under whole topsails
with ice in sight So ends the day

Friday 6th
Commences with a light breeze from the Eastward
Ship under topsails & jibs boat down in the ice looking
for whales at six feet hoist up middle part wind came
to S.E. & breeze on D.R. the topsails latter part Foggy
So Ends

Saturday 7th
Commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. Ship
under all sail on opposite tacks middle part shut
in Foggy latter part much the same So ends
this day

Sunday 8th
Commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. Ship
under D.R. topsail & staysails on opposite tacks middle
part light wind latter part 12 out catching Walrus
caught twenty So ends

Monday 9th
Commences with a light breeze from the S.E.
Ship under all sail on opposite tacks the watch
employed skinning walrus middle & latter
part the same So ends this day
