Remarks On Board Ship The Dickason

Friday Oct 4th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N^W ship under topsails & courses steering S by E per compass middle part wind moderates & sails to the South make all sail so end this day

Lat 53.57 Lon 170.30

Saturday 5th

Commences with a light breeze from the South ship under all sail on opposite tack working to the S E middle part wind sails to west & breeze on S breeze make the Island Youngska pass through between the Island of four Mountains & Youngska

Sunday 6th

Commences with a strong westerly wind ship under all sail steering S E by E per compass middle part wind sails to the S S E & breeze on to a gale have her to under double main-
top sail & staysails so end this day

Monday 7th

Commences with a S E gale ship under to on the Starboard tack under close reef main topsail & staysails middle part the same latter part wind sails to N W ship under D R topsails & courses steering S E by E per compass so end this day

Tuesday 8th

Commences with a strong S W wind ship under D R topsails & courses steering S E by E per compass middle part squally carry away the jib latter part more moderate bend to west jib so end this day

Wednesday 9th

Commences with a light breeze from the S W ship under all sail steering S E by E per compass middle part wind sails to the N W send out for the mast Studding sail so end

Thursday 10th

Lat 45.36 Lon 160.01

Commences with a fine breeze from the N W ship under all sail steering S E per compass middle part squally with rain latter part fine weather men employed at ship duty so end

Lat 43.29 Lon 158.37

Friday 11th

Commences with a light breeze from the N W middle part the same latter part wind sails to the North weather employed fishing Dore so end this day

Lat 41.01 Lon 156.05

Saturday 12th

Commences with a light breeze from the North ship under all sail steering S E middle part calm latter part wind breeze up from the South strong ship under double reef topsails & courses so end this day

Lat 40.05

Sunday 13th

Commences with a gale from the South ship under D R topsails & staysails middle part wind sails to the west ship steering S E by E per compass so end

Lat 38.52

Monday 14th

Commences with a strong southerly wind ship under D R topsails & courses heading S E by E middle & latter part squally with rain so end this day
