Remarks on board of Ship *Wm. Dickason*

Tuesday 15th of Oct

Commences with a strong breeze from the South Ship under whole topsails & courses middle part D-R hand jib & mainsail latter part hand & topsail & foresail flowing strong so ends
Lat 36.31

Wednesday 16th

Commences with a strong southerly gale Ship here to at the starboard tack heading E. S. E middle part squally with rain latter part wind shifts to the North make all sail steering S. by E so ends

Lat 35.44

Thursday 17th

Commences with a light breeze from the N.E. Ship under all sail steering S by E per compass middle part wind came to the South & breezes on D-R the topsail latter part the same so ends

Friday 18th

Commences with a strong breeze from the South Ship under D-R topsails & courses on opposite tack middle & latter part much the same so ends this day
Lat 35.52

Saturday 19th

Commences with a light breeze from the South Ship under all sail with starboard tack aboard heading W. S. W. wind veering to the eastward middle & latter part ship steering South so ends this day
Lat 32.25 Lon 152.26

Sunday 20th

Commences with a strong breeze from the E. S. E Ship under all sail heading S by W per compass middle & latter part much the same so ends this day
Lat 30.05 Lon 152.06

Bound on a whaling voyage to the Pacific Ocean

Monday 21st of Oct 1861

Commences with a strong easterly wind Ship under all sail steering S by W per compass middle part wind came to the South with squally weather latter part the same so ends this day
Lat 28.29

Tuesday 22nd

Commences with variable wind & squally weather wind veering from South to S.W. middle part westerly wind latter part N.W. wind Ship under all sail steering S by E per compass so ends

Lat 27.31 Lon 152.05 Wednesday 23rd

Commences with a N.W. wind Ship under all sail steering South per compass middle part wind came to the North & moderates latter part veering to the eastward Men employed washing & Dore so ends this day
Lat 25.21

Thursday 24th

Commences with a light breeze from the North Ship under all sail steering South per compass middle part wind came to N.E. latter part breezes on men employed Drying & Bundling & Dore so ends
Lat 23.46 Lon 152.43

Friday 25th

Commences with a fine breeze from the N.E. Ship under all sail steering S by W per compass middle part the same latter part strong breeze men employed Bundling & Dore so ends
Lat 20.52 Lon 153.49

Saturday 26th

Commences with a strong N.E. wind Ship under all sail steering S by W middle part hand the light sail & sent up the courses make all sail at 8 P.M. with Goryhee in sight Ship standing along shore to the westward so ends
