

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of

Saturday October 11th 1862
Forepart moderate southeasterly winds, the ship on the starboard tack. Letterpart moderate southwesterly winds, steering E. Carrying all sail.

Sunday 12th
Forepart a moderate southwesterly wind, the ship under all sail steering east. Middle and latterpart strong variable southerly winds, the ship under short sail, on the starboard tack till 10 P.M., then kept off, steering east.

Lat 46° 35' N Lon 153° 04' W Monday 13th
Strong southerly winds, the ship under easy sail, steering east. Shifted the fore topsail.

Lat 46° 48' N Lon 152° 45' Tuesday 14th
Moderate and light winds, in the forepart southerly, latterpart westerly. Steering east, under all sail.

Lat 46° 00' Wednesday 15th
Forepart and middle light variable southwesterly winds steering E & S. Letterpart light southeasterly winds, the ship on opposite tacks. Carrying all sail. Employed at scraping whalebone.

Thursday 16th
Forepart light, latterpart strong variable southeasterly winds. On opposite tacks, under prudent sail.

Friday 17th
Forepart and middle, ~~the~~ blowing a gale from the southward. The ship hove to on the eastern tack under a close reefed all topsail. Letterpart the wind hauled to the westward and moderated some steering east.

Beaford: Bound on a Cape Horn whaling voyage.

Lat 45° 12' N Lon 146° 00' W Saturday Oct 18th 1862
Strong variable southwesterly winds, with some fog. The ship under prudent sail, steering east.

Sunday 19th
In the forepart, moderate southerly winds, the ship going her course E by S. Letterpart, light variable, southeasterly winds, the ship on the eastern tack carrying all sail throughout the day. Considerable fog.

Monday 20th
Light variable southeasterly winds, with fog. The ship on the starboard tack, under all sail.

Tuesday 21st
Light, variable, easterly winds. The ship on opposite tacks. Carrying all sail.

Lat 43° 23' N Lon 139° 41' Wednesday 22nd
Light, variable, easterly winds. The ship on opposite tacks, under all sail. The watch employed at washing whalebone.

Lat 43° 47' N Lon 138° 31' Thursday 23rd
Light, variable, southeasterly winds. The ship on opposite tacks, under all sail. Employed at washing bone.

Lat 43° 54' N Lon 136° 18' Friday 24th
Forepart, light, variable, southeasterly winds, the ship, by the wind on the eastern tack. Letterpart, light, variable, southwesterly winds; the ship, steering E, S, E. Carrying all sail. Saw a lark steering about N, E.

Saturday 25th
Forepart, light, variable, westerly winds; latterpart, light, variable, breezes. Carrying all sail. Steering E, S, E when there is wind enough.
