

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of B.

Lat 28°20' N. Lon 118°33' W. Friday, April 17th, 1863.
Moderate, northeasterly winds. The ship under
topgallant sails; steering northwest.

Lat 30°00' north Saturday 18th
Moderate northeasterly winds. The ship under all sail
; steering N N W. Repairing and painting boats.

Lat 32°24' Lon 118°00' E Sunday 19th
Light, variable, easterly winds. Carrying all sail; steering N N W.

No observation. Monday 20th
Forepart; light, variable, southerly winds. The ship under
all sail; steering N N W. Latter part, middling strong
northerly winds. On the starboard tack; under prudent sail.

Lat 35°20' north Tuesday 21st
Middling strong winds, from north to east; the
ship under prudent sail; steering N N W when the wind allows.

Lat 38°18' Lon 118°02' E Wednesday 22nd
Moderate southeasterly winds, with cloudy weather.
Under all sail. Steering N N W, and north by west.

Thursday 23rd
Moderate southerly winds; with some fog. Forepart
steering N by W; Latter part, N N W. Carrying all sail.

Lat 44°20' Lon 116°29' Friday 24th
Winds principally from the westward; some of the
time quite strong, and some moderate. The ship
under prudent sail. Course, north northwest.

Lat 45°30' Lon 116°03' Friday Saturday 25th
Forepart, on the port tack, heading to the northward
and eastward, under short sail. Latter part, on the starboard
tack, heading to the northwesternward; under all sail. Course, N N W.

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Latitude, 48°13' north. Sunday, April 26th, 1863.
Forepart a moderate southerly wind; under all sail.
Latter part strong southerly winds; under short sail. Steering N N W.

Lat 49°06' Monday 28th
Forepart strong southwesterly winds; under short
sail steering N W. Middle, blowing a westerly gale;
the ship on opposite tacks laying to. Latter part the
wind was more moderate, but still from the west-
ward, the ship on the northern tack, with short sail.

Tuesday 28th
Winds principally from the south, southwest,
west, and northwest. The ship under prudent sail
steering N W by E, when the wind favored it.

Lat 50°35' Lon 114°51' west. Wednesday 29th
Strong, variable westerly winds, with
under short sail, on opposite tacks. Course N N W.

Thursday 30th
Strong, variable westerly winds, in the fore part,
with some squalls of snow. The ship on the
starboard tack. Latter part, the wind more
moderate; on the port tack. Under prudent sail throughout.

Friday May 1st
Moderate, variable, northwesterly winds, with cloudy
weather. The ship on opposite tacks, by the wind
carrying topgallant sails part of the time.

Lat 51°30' Lon 113°23' Saturday 2nd
Light, variable, northwesterly winds, in the fore, and
middle parts of the day. At 12, M. saw one of the
most western of the Fox Islands, bearing N N W by
compass 12 miles, we suppose it to be St. Michael's.
Latter part, moderate southeasterly winds. Steering northwest.
