

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickson, of New Bedford.

Lat 51° 39' N Lon 171° 09' W. Thursday, October 1st, 1863.
Variable southeasterly winds; forepart moderate, latterpart middling strong. The ship under prudent sail, by the wind, on opposite tack.

No observation. Friday, 2nd.
Forepart middling strong southeasterly winds. The ship on opposite tacks. Latterpart middling strong northeasterly winds; steering southeast. Carrying prudent sail throughout the day.

Blowing strong from the northward. Saturday, 3rd.
Ship under prudent sail. Steering ESE.

Lat 46° 26' Lon 162° 36'. Sunday, 4th.
Forepart strong northeasterly winds. Steering ESE, with prudent sail. Shipped a sea which carried away the gangway-board, at 2 A.M. Middle, and latterpart the wind more moderate, steering E.

Lat 45° 18' Lon 159° 02'. Monday, 5th.
Forepart moderate westerly winds; steering east. Latterpart light variable southerly winds; steering east. The ship under all sail the greatest part of the day.

Tuesday, 6th.
Light variable southwesterly winds in the forepart and middle; steering east, and east by south. Latterpart light westerly winds; steering east. The ship under all sail. Employed scraping here.

Lat 43° 18' Lon 154° 01'. Wednesday, 7th.
Light westerly winds. The ship under all sail. Forepart, steering east; latterpart, east by south.

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Lat 42° 25' N Lon 150° 43' W. Thursday, October 8th, 1863.
Forepart light variable southerly winds. The ship going from east to ENE. Latterpart, strong westerly winds; steering east. Carrying prudent sail throughout.

Lat 41° 10' Lon 146° 49'. Friday, 9th.
Forepart moderate westerly winds; under all sail, steering east. Scraped, some whale bone. Latterpart, strong southerly winds; the ship on the eastern tack, under short sail.

Lat 40° 50'. Saturday, 10th.
Commenced with strong southerly winds; the ship under short sail on the eastern tack. Middle, middling strong southwesterly winds with strong squalls; under prudent sail steering SSE. Latterpart, the wind more moderate, and westerly; steering E, with all sail.

Lat 39° 40' Lon 139° 33'. Sunday, 11th.
Forepart moderate westerly winds; steering ESE. Middle, light westerly winds, with southerly variations; steering east. Latterpart, light variable southerly winds; course E. Carrying necessary sail throughout.

Monday, 12th.
Forepart moderate variable winds from the SE. The ship on the eastern tack. Middle, squally with variable southwesterly winds; steering ESE by N. Latterpart moderate westerly winds; steering E. Forepart, the ship under easy sail; latterpart carrying the main royal.

Lat 38° 20' Lon 133° 34'. Tuesday, 13th.
Moderate and light variable westerly winds. Forepart, steering east; latterpart, east by north. Carrying all sail. Employed at washing whale bone.
