

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickson, of New Bedford

Lat, 12°36' N. Lon, 118°29' W. Monday, February 29th, 1864.
Forepart light variable airs. Scatterpart,
moderate northeasterly winds, with some rain
squalls. Course SSW. Carrying requisite sail.

Tuesday, March 1st.
Moderate northeasterly winds, with the same
rain squalls. Course SSW. Under necessary sail.

Lat 8°56' Lon, 121°22' W. Wednesday, 2nd.
Moderate northeasterly winds. Forepart and middle
steering SSW. Scatterpart, by the wind on the
port tack. Under easy sail throughout the day.

Lat, 7°22'. Thursday, 3rd.
Middling strong northeasterly winds. The ship
under easy sail; on opposite tacks.

Friday, 4th.
Middling strong northeasterly winds.
The ship under sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, 8°07'. Saturday, 5th.
Moderate, and middling strong northeasterly
winds. The ship on opposite tacks; under easy sail.

Lat, 8°08'. Sunday, 6th.
Moderate and, middling strong northeasterly winds.
The ship under easy sail cruising for sperm whales.

Lat, 7°19'. Monday, 7th.
Moderate northeasterly winds. The ship under
easy sail; cruising for sperm whales.

Lat, 8°04'. Tuesday, 8th.
Moderate northeasterly winds. Forepart, by
the wind on the starboard tack; middle, steering W by E;
scatterpart steering W by N. Carrying necessary sail.

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Lat, 8°42' N. Lon, 126°19' W. Wednesday, March 9th, 1864.
Moderate and light northeasterly winds. The
ship under all sail, steering west northwest.

Lat, 9°38'. Thursday, 10th.
Moderate northeast trade-winds. The ship
under all sail; steering west northwest.

Lat, 10°42' Lon, 129°19'. Friday, 11th.
Moderate northeast trades. Saw whales, which proved
to be finbacks. Steering W by N. Carrying all sail.

Lat, 11°50' Lon, 131°24'. Saturday, 12th.
Moderate northeast trade-winds.
The ship under all sail; steering W by N.

Lat, 11°50'. Sunday, 13th.
Moderate and light variable northeasterly
winds. The ship under all sail; steering W by N.

Lat, 12°56' Lon, 133°48'. Monday, 14th.
Moderate variable northeasterly winds. The ship
under all sail. Course W by N. Painting ship on the inside.

Lat, 13°52'. Tuesday, 15th.
Moderate and middling strong variable northeasterly
winds, with some rain. Employed at painting the
ship on the inside. Forepart, under all sail, steering
W by N. Scatterpart, under topsail, and courses, steering W by N.

Lat, 14°45'. Wednesday, 16th.
Strong northeast trades. The ship
under necessary sail; steering W by N.

Lat, 16°16' Lon, 141°31'. Thursday, 17th.
Strong northeast trades. Forepart, steering W by N.
Scatterpart, steering W by N. Under prudent sail.
