

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of N Bedford.

March.

Lat, 18° 24'. Lon, 144° 46'. W. Friday, February 18th 1864.
Middling strong northeast tradewinds. The ship
under full sail; steering west by north.

Lat, 18° 28'. N. Lon, 144° 54'. Saturday, 19th.
Middling strong northeast tradewinds.
The ship under all sail; steering W by N.

Lat, 18° 30'. Lon, 15° 12'. Sunday, 20th.
Middling strong northeast tradewinds.
Forepart steering W by N; latter part W. Under all sail.

Lat, 20° 04'. Lon, 154° 11'. Monday, 21st.
Middling strong and moderate northeast trades.
Steering W, till 6 P.M., then steered W by S.
At 6 P.M. saw a part of the island of Hawaii.
Forepart, under all sail. Latter part, under easy sail.

Tuesday, 22nd.
Light and moderate variable winds. The
ship under necessary sail, working towards
Hawaii Bay, till 2 P.M., then took a pilot, and
came to an anchor there, in eight fathoms of water.
About 12 P.M. had strong mill-waves from off of
land, from the northeast; and let go the second anchor.

Wednesday, 23rd.
Moderate variable winds. Laying anchored at Hawaii Bay.
Hove up, catbed, and fished, the starboard anchor.

Thursday, 24th.
Forepart strong northeast winds; hauled out
chain to the port anchor, to 75 fathoms. Latter part,
moderate variable southerly winds; employed at
getting on board firewood, from the shore.

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Friday, March, 25th, 1864.

Moderate variable winds. The ship laying at
an anchor at Hawaii Bay, Hawaii, Islands.
Employed at getting firewood, and potatoes.

Saturday, 26th.
Light and moderate variable winds. At eight
o'clock P.M., hove in 40 fathoms of slack chain.

Sunday, 27th.
Forepart, light and moderate variable winds.
At 3, A.M., got underway with a light northeast
wind, and made all sail. Course W by N. Latter part,
strong N.E. trades. Steering about W by N. for
Honolulu; the ship under prudent sail.

Monday, 28th.
Middling strong N.E. trades. Arrived off the
harbor of Honolulu, Oahu, about noon, and Captain
Stewart went on shore. Latter part, laying off and on at Oahu.

Tuesday, 29th.
Middling strong northeast trades. The
ship off and on at Oahu. Carrying prudent sail.

Wednesday, 30th.
Middling strong northeast tradewinds.
Laying off and on at Oahu. Under prudent sail.

Thursday, 31st.
Middling strong northeast trades.
The ship under prudent sail,
laying off and on at Honolulu,
Oahu. Sent a boat to the town.
