

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Lat, $68^{\circ}41'N$. Friday, July 1st, 1864.
Middling strong southerly winds with fog.
The ship under short sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, $68^{\circ}46'$. Saturday, 2nd.
Moderate southerly winds, with considerable fog.
Under easy sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, $68^{\circ}42'$. Sunday, 3rd.
Moderate and light variable southwesterly winds,
with some fog in the forepart. The ship under
necessary sail, cruising around the ice.

Monday, 4th.
Moderate northwesterly winds. The ship under
necessary sail, working to the southward along
the ice. Took out one of the top pots, and set a new one.

Tuesday, 5th.
Moderate and light variable northwesterly winds,
with some fog. The ship under necessary sail,
working to the westward, along the ice. Spoke
ships, George Howland, of N. S. Sea, W. W. of New London.

Wednesday, 6th.
Light northwesterly winds. The ship under
necessary sail, on opposite tacks, laying back in
the fore part of the time. Stowed 48003 gallons whale oil.

Lat, $68^{\circ}30'$. Thursday, 7th.
Moderate northwesterly winds, with some fog.
Saw some ice. Under requisite sail, on opposite tacks.
Spoke bark ~~the~~ Mercury, of N. Bedford.

Lat, $68^{\circ}13'$. Friday, 8th.
Middling strong, and moderate, northerly winds. The
ship under easy sail, on opposite tacks. Saw some
ice. Spoke ship Edward Cary, of Nantucket.

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Saturday, July 9th, 1864.
Moderate and light northerly winds, with some
fog. The ship under necessary sail, cruising
in the vicinity of the ice. Caught four walrus.

Sunday, 10th.
Moderate and middling strong northerly
winds with some fog. The ship under easy
sail, cruising in the vicinity of the ice.

Lat, $68^{\circ}20'N$. Monday, 11th.
Moderate and middling strong northerly winds, with
considerable fog. Under easy sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, $68^{\circ}24'$. Tuesday, 12th.
Moderate northerly winds, with some fog. The
ship under requisite sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, $68^{\circ}45'$. Wednesday, 13th.
Moderate, and middling strong, northerly winds,
with some fog. The ship under necessary sail,
cruising in and around the ice. Saw considerable
many walrus. Spoke bark ~~the~~ Fitzgerald, of Edgartown.

Lat, $68^{\circ}56'$. Thursday, 14th.
Middling strong and moderate northerly winds.
The ship under short sail, cruising in and around the ice.

Lat, $68^{\circ}48'$. Lat, $173^{\circ}43'W$. Friday, 15th.
Moderate northerly winds, with some fog. Under
necessary sail, cruising around the ice. Caught 13 walrus.

Lat, $68^{\circ}32'$. Saturday, 16th.
Moderate and light northerly winds. Under
necessary sail, cruising around the ice.
