

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Monday, August 1st, 1864.
Light variable winds. The ship in and around
ice under necessary sail. Lowered for a whale.

Tuesday, 2nd.
Middling strong and moderate variable northerly
winds. Under requisite sail. Cruising near the ice.

Lat, 69°14' N. Wednesday, 3rd.
Moderate, variable, westerly winds. Under necessary sail,
cruising around ice. Spoke ship *Abeline* of N. Bedford.

Lat, 69°08'. Thursday, 4th.
Middling strong, moderate, and light, variable
westerly winds. Under requisite sail, cruising in
and around the ice. Lowered for whales.

Friday, 5th.
Middling strong, and moderate, variable, easterly
winds. The ship under requisite sail, cruising
around the ice. Lowered for a whale.

Lat, 69°28'. Saturday, 6th.
Moderate variable northerly winds, with some
fog, and rain. The ship under easy sail, cruising
around the ice. Lowered twice for whales.

Lat, 69°34'. Sunday, 7th.
Light, moderate, and strong, northerly winds.
Cruising around the ice under prudent sail.
Lowered for a whale. Spoke ship *Bumwink*, of N. B.

Monday, 8th.
Middling strong variable northerly winds. Cruising
around the ice under necessary sail.
Spoke ship *Nassau*, of New Bedford.
Considerable snow fell during the day.

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Lat, 69°33' N. Longitude, 174°02' W. Tuesday, August 9th, 1864.
Moderate and light variable northerly winds; with some
fog. Under necessary sail; cruising around the ice.
Rent a new main-topmast stay sail.

Wednesday, 10th.
Light and moderate variable northerly winds
with some fog and snow. Cruising around the
ice with requisite sail. The whale boat caught
a whale and got it to the ship at 11 o'clock P.M.

Thursday, 11th.
Light and moderate winds, from N. N. W., with some
fog and snow. Cut the whale and commenced to
bail. Under requisite sail, around the ice.

Friday, 12th.
Moderate and light northwesterly winds, with some
fog. Cruising amongst scattering ice; under
easy sail. Lowered one boat for a whale.

Saturday, 13th.
Moderate, variable, westerly winds; with some fog and
rain. Cruising amongst the ice; under requisite sail.

Lat, 69°45'. Sunday, 14th.
Light variable northwesterly winds, with some fog.
Cruising near the ice under requisite sail.

Monday, 15th.
Light variable southeasterly winds with some fog.
The ship under necessary sail; cruising around
the ice. Lowered for a bowhead whale.
Stowed 44.11 gallons of whale oil.

Lat, 69°45'. Tuesday, 16th.
Moderate southeasterly winds. Under necessary sail;
cruising around the ice. Spoke bark *fish Swift*, of N. B.
