

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Civil account.

Lat, 6° 25' N. Sunday, January 1st, 1865.
Middling strong, moderate, and light, variable, southeasterly winds. The ship under prudent sail, on the larboard tack.

Lat, 5° 30' S. Mon, 10° 20' W. Monday, 2nd.
Moderate, and light, variable, easterly winds, with some rain squalls. The ship under requisite sail, cruising to the southward.

Tuesday, 3rd.
Moderate, variable southeasterly winds, with rain squalls. The ship under prudent sail on, opposite tacks.

Lat, 0° 40'. Wednesday, 4th.
Moderate, variable, southeasterly winds. The ship under requisite sail, by the wind, on opposite tacks.

Lat, 0° 48' S. Mon, 10° 15' W. Thursday, 5th.
Moderate variable southeasterly winds. The ship under necessary sail, on opposite tacks, by the wind.

Lat, 2° 52'. Friday, 6th.
Moderate southeasterly winds. The ship under necessary sail, by the wind, on the port tack.

Lat, 0° 56'. Saturday, 7th.
Moderate, variable, southeasterly winds, with some squalls. Under requisite sail, on the port tack.

Lat, 0° 44' S. Mon, 10° 42' W. Sunday, 8th.
Moderate southeasterly winds. The ship under requisite sail, by the wind, on the port tack.

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Lat, 0° 05' N. Monday, January 8th, 1865.
Moderate southeasterly winds. The ship cruising for whales, under requisite sail, till about 9 P.M., then lowered for sperm whales, and the waist and starboard boats, got one each, and got them alongside about six P.M. Signalized an English ship, steering northwesterly.

Lat, 0° 30'. Tuesday, 9th.
Moderate southeasterly winds. The ship under easy sail, on opposite tacks. Got the whales, &c.

Lat, 0° 16' S. Mon, 11° 46' W. Wednesday, 11th.
Moderate, southeasterly, winds. Employed at boiling blubber. On opposite tacks; under requisite sail.

Lat, 0° 10' S. Mon, 11° 49' W. Thursday, 12th.
Moderate southeasterly winds. Saw sperm whales from 8 A.M. till sunset, but could not get near enough to them, to lower the boats. Finished boiling. The ship under requisite sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, 0° 18' S. Mon, 11° 42' W. Friday, 13th.
Moderate and light southeasterly winds. The ship under requisite sail, cruising for whales.

Lat, 0° 30' N. Mon, 11° 08' W. Saturday, 14th.
Moderate and light southeasterly winds. The ship under necessary sail, cruising for whales.

Lat, 0° 09' S. Mon, 11° 17' W. Sunday, 15th.
Moderate, southeasterly, winds. The ship under requisite sail, cruising for whales.

Lat, 0° 00' S. Mon, 11° 41' W. Monday, 16th.
Moderate, and middling strong, southeasterly winds, with squalls. Under easy sail, on the port tack.
