Lat, 00,24. S. Lon, 108,43. Sunday, 29th.
Moderate southeast trade winds. Cruising for whales.

Lat, 00,12. N. Lon, 109,10. Monday, 30th.
Moderate southeast trade winds.
Under necessary sail; cruising for whales.

Lat, 00,24. S. Lon, 110,06. Tuesday, 31st.
Moderate southeast trades. Cruising for whales.

Lat, 00,20. N. Wednesday, February 1st, 1865.
Light and moderate southeast trade winds.
The ship under requisite sail; cruising for whales.

Light and moderate southerly winds; with some rain. Under requisite sail; cruising for whales.

Light and moderate variable, southerly winds.
Carrying necessary sail; cruising for sperm.

Lat, 00,05. Saturday, 4th.
Light, and moderate, variable, southerly winds.
Cruising under requisite sail.

Lat, 00,00. Sunday, 5th.
Light and moderate variable southerly winds; with some squalls. Under requisite sail; cruising.
