

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickson, of Bedford.

Lat, 01, 46. S. Longitude, 124, 11. W. Wednesday, Feb 22nd, 1865.
Moderate southeast trades. The ship under requisite sail; cruising to the southwestward.

Lat, 03, 20. Lon, 124, 35. W. Thursday, 23rd.
Moderate and middling strong southeast trades. Under necessary sail on the port tack.

Lat, 05, 40. Lon, 124, 28. Friday, 24th.
Moderate southeast trades with some squalls. Sailed for blackfish. Under requisite sail on the port tack.

Lat, 05, 10. Lon, 124, 44. Saturday, 25th.
Moderate southeast trades. The ship under requisite sail on the port tack.

Lat, 07, 05. Lon, 123, 30. Sunday, 26th.
Moderate southeast trades. The ship on opposite tacks working to the windward after sperm whales which were in sight from 8 A.M. till sundown at which time we lowered the boats for them, without success.

Lat, 08, 20. Lon, 123, 29. Monday, 27th.
Moderate southeast trades. The ship under requisite sail, cruising for whales. Hunt a new main topgallant sail.

Lat, 07, 33. Lon, 123, 37. Tuesday, 28th.
Middling strong southeast trades. Under requisite sail cruising for whales.

Lat, 09, 25. S. Lon, 124, 17. W. Wednesday, March 1st, 1865.
Moderate southeast tradewinds. The ship under necessary sail; cruising to the southward.

Lat, 11, 18. S. Lon, 124, 10. Thursday, 2nd.
Light and moderate southeast trades. The ship under all sail on the southern tack.

Lat, 12, 42. S. Lon, 124, 12. Friday, 3rd.
Light southeast trade-winds. The ship under all sail on the southern tack.

Lat, 13, 52. S. Lon, 124, 12. Saturday, 4th.
Light southeast trades. The ship under all sail on the southern tack.

Lat, 14, 25. S. Lon, 124, 48. Sunday, 5th.
Light variable airs. The ship under all sail. Course, south by east.

Lat, 14, 40. S. Lon, 124, 40. Monday, 6th.
Light variable winds. The ship under all sail on opposite tacks part of the time, and steering S by E the remainder. Saw a shoal of sperm whales.

Lat, 15, 15. S. Lon, 124, 34. Tuesday, 7th.
Light variable easterly winds. The ship under all sail. Course, south by east.

Lat, 16, 45. S. Lon, 125, 06. Wednesday, 8th.
Light variable easterly winds. The ship under requisite sail. Course S by E.

Lat, 18, 18. S. Lon, 125, 02. Thursday, 9th.
Light variable easterly winds. The ship under all sail; steering south by east.
