

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Saturday, May 13th, 1865.

Middling strong, and moderate, winds, from the north-westward. The ship under requisite sail; steering S. by E. & S. E. by N. Passed four merchant ships, two of which, the *Helene* of Liverpool, and *Henry Brigham* of San Francisco we read the names.

Sunday, 14th.

Commences with moderate, north-easterly winds; steering S. by N. Middle and latter part, middling strong, and moderate variable northerly winds; course S. E. Carrying requisite sail throughout the day. At 8 A.M. saw the Diego Ramirez Islands, bearing about N.W.

Lat, 56° 49' S. Lon, 63° 04' W. Monday, 15th. Moderate, and light, variable, north-westerly winds. Carrying all sail; courses N. E. & S. E. by E. Saw an iceberg; also a bark, bound northeast.

Lat, 56° 02' S. Lon, 62° 12' W. Tuesday, 16th. Light moderate and middling strong, variable northerly winds. The ship under requisite sail, on the port tack. Saw four vessels, bound to the northeast.

Wednesday, 17th. Middling strong, moderate, and light, variable north-westerly winds. Under requisite sail, on the port tack.

Thursday, 18th. Middling strong, and moderate, northerly winds. The ship under prudent sail, on the eastern tack.

Friday, 19th. Middling strong variable northerly winds. On the eastern tack under necessary sail.

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Lat 53° 46' S. Lon, 53° 47' W. Saturday, May 20th, 1865. Moderate, and light, variable, north-easterly winds; and calms. The ship under necessary sail, on whichever tack she would head steered to N. Spoke bark *Templar*, of N York, bound to Cork.

Lat 53° 10' N. Sunday, 21st. Moderate and middling strong, north-easterly winds, with some fog. The ship under requisite sail, on the starboard tack. Died, at 3 P.M. Jonathan Johnston, seaman. Deceased had been deranged, for several months; was about 35 years of age, and is supposed to have belonged to Missouri.

Lat, 54° 12' S. Lon, 53° 01' W. Monday, 22nd. Calms, light variable airs, and moderate, variable, northerly winds. The ship under requisite sail, working to the northward. At 12, M, buried the remains of Jonathan Johnston.

Tuesday 23rd. Moderate, and light winds; varying from N. E. to N. W. Under necessary sail, on opposite tacks.

Lat, 53° 18' S. Lon, 50° 01' W. Wednesday 24th. Moderate, and middling strong, northerly, and north-westerly, winds. Under requisite sail, on the port tack.

Thursday, 25th. Light, moderate, and strong, northerly, and north-westerly winds. The ship under prudent sail. Course, S. by E.

Lat, 50° 51' S. Lon, 43° 33' W. Friday, 26th. Middling strong and moderate, north-westerly winds. Carrying requisite sail. Steering S. by E. & N. E. by E.
