

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Lat, 26° 16' N. Saturday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1865.  
Light, variable, northeasterly and  
southeasterly winds. Saw two  
vessels bound to the northward, and one  
to the southward. All sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 27° 44' Lon, 68° 54' W. Sat Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup>.  
Light, variable, southerly winds. Saw 3  
vessels. Carrying all sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 29° 09' Lon, 64° 30' Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup>.  
Light, variable, southwesterly winds. Saw  
one vessel. Carrying all sail. Steering N E by N.

Lat, 30° 13' Lon, 65° 20' Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup>.  
Light and moderate variable winds with  
thunder showers. All sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 30° 58' Lon, 65° 18' Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup>.  
Light and moderate variable winds; principally  
from the westward. All sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 32° 52' Lon, 65° 53' Thursday, 6<sup>th</sup>.  
Moderate, and middling strong winds, mostly  
from the northward. Under requisite sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 33° 18' Lon, 66° 58' Friday, 7<sup>th</sup>.  
Light, variable winds. Saw several  
vessels. The ship under all sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 34° 45' Lon, 67° 45' Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup>.  
Moderate, variable, westerly winds.  
Carrying requisite sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 36° 31' Lon, 68° 36' Sunday, 9<sup>th</sup>.  
Moderate variable winds; principally from  
the westward. Spoke Capt. Eliza of New  
Bedford. Carrying requisite sail. Course N E by N.

Remarks on board ship Thomas Dickason, of New Bedford.

Lat, 38° 05' N. Lon, 69° 20' W. Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 1865.  
Moderate and light variable easterly winds.  
The ship under all sail. Course N E by N.

Lon, 70° 45' Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup>.  
Commences with moderate S E winds; middle,  
middling strong southwesterly winds; latter part,  
variable northerly winds. Saw several vessels.  
Carrying requisite sail. Course N E by N.

Lat, 40° 00' Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup>.  
Forepart, light and moderate southwesterly  
winds. Course N E by N. Middle and  
latter parts variable southeasterly winds  
with rain. At 12 M, steered northeast.  
At 5 P M saw Cuttyhunk Island and the  
S S P light boat. Took a pilot at six  
and came to an anchor near Clark's  
Point, at nine P M.
