 All this day very fine weather the cooper setting up pipes four water and got sun potatoes on board sun bats from another ship & cooper setting up pipes four water & is throughout the night had sun rain

 All this day very fine weather let one watch go on show and the getting the rigging & c in order cooper setting up water pipes four water and getting in fruit & c

 Saturday June the 18  
 All this day very fine weather let part of the crew go on show & the cooper setting up pipes four water and a man went of throughout the night and carried of his things William herberton the ship cooper so ends these 24 hours

 All this day very fine pleasant weather let sun on the crew go on show and sent in 24 of salt or water to drink At knight the people returned to the ship so ends these 24 hours got of sun glasses & oranges & c

 All this 24 hours cloudy & fine weather got of a keft or water and stowed it down in the main hatch got two hot loads of yams & sent oranges let sun on the crew go on show so ends the day

 All this day very fine weather getting of our kecurit and got of a keft or water & stowed it down between decks and got very clear four sea so ends the 24 hours

 All this day very fine weather let sun on the people got on show got the ship all rigging four to go to sea At knight all hands on board but William herberton he left and Henry Driver & bot Steamer so ends the day getting of our kecurit & c for fruit

*Remark on Board Thursday June the 24*  
 Thursday June the 24  
 This day commences with very fine weather and light land breeze At 10 AM Pilot came on board have short and made all sail broke out the anchor and Tricahit on the harbor At 10 AM pilot left got out clear cleared up decks when the show stood the other & hand Capt Manwarren went on show for four men two frenchmen & a portugese and a commander boy At knight took ship thick and cloudy Capt Manwarren left his bill to the council to end the day  
*Remark on board Friday June the 25*  
 Friday June the 25  
 All this day very fresh winds and good weather starting of 8 on At 4 AM saw Sperdew Whales off & landed in three struck one large whale within 6 miles of the land killed him At 11 got him in At half past 12 commenced cutting the whale got him in At 4 AM cleared up decks the next three large whale the other two went of At knight Double kept the topsail standing of 8 on the land so ends the day

 All this day very fine weather fine breeze from the SE At daylight commence boiling the whale stude intoward the land Capt Manwarren went on show gave his bill to the council At knight all hands on board Shift a weather man is irishman Double kept the topsail standing of show so ends the day

 Sunday June the 27  
 All this day very fine weather Implaced in boiling the whale standing of 8 on saw one ship came out of the harbor Nothing in life so ends the day  
*Remark on board Monday June the 28*  
 Monday June the 28  
 This 24 hours very fine weather all sail set to advantage winds from ESE one hot went in show a whale Nothing in life got through boiling the whale and c broke out the fore hatch & staid it over At knight saw the Island or fire so ends the day  
*Remark on Board Tuesday June the 29*  
 Tuesday June the 29  
 All this day very fine weather all sail set to advantage standing of 8 on broke out the main hatch & staid down the oil 70 barrels out of the cooper expiring the provisions saw pinbacks At knight land distant 80 miles so ends the day Make ship. Canten or Newlands food 36 month out 2100 barrels on show
