Monday July 26

Remark on Board Monday July the 26
All these 24 hours very good weather strong breeze from the SE to ESE all sail set to advantage the Elvise in the the People Implied in making Shungorn & making a main Spencer Nation to be seen or shall latter 11:23 long 1:51:00

Tuesday July 27

Remark on Board Tuesday July the 27
All this day very fine weather ship under double reefed topsails & mainsail at daylight saw the Island or Remoture distant 20 miles trying to beat up to it in company with the Elvise making in the boat land latter long 1:51:00

Wednesday July 28 18:41

Remark on Board Wednesday July the 28
All these 24 hours very strong winds from the South beating up to the Island land distant 20 miles the ship Elvise in the the People Implied at ship duty to end the day latter 22:28 long 1:51:03

Thursday July 29

Remark on Board Thursday July the 29
All these 24 hours strong breeze from the SE beating up to the Island to get sun fresh & the Elvise in the the People Implied in this duty ship under double reefed topsails & gib & mainsail latter 22:26 long 1:51:00

Friday July 30

Remark on Board Friday July the 30
All this day very good weather all sail set beating up to the Island at 5:00 all got clean & shipped to four that in boat with that got long time but two days came on board & under the yards four & another Island latter long

Saturday July 31

Remark on Board Saturday July the 31
All these 24 hours very fine weather all sail set to advantage hauled to Remoture to get bags & at night saw the Island bearing WNW distant 30 miles in company with the Elvise saw pinbacks to end the day latter 22:48 long 1:51

Remark on Board Sunday August the 1
All this day very fine weather ship under double reefed topsails beating up to Encarnacion four bags & I got up to the Island and at 10:00 came up and we went in four our Ylervate to end the day at night all hands on board to end the day one or the men came up for to begin some things

Monday August the 2

Remark on Board Monday August the 2
All these 24 hours very strong all winds beating up to the Island and at the other ship in company we have one or the men on board could not get up to it split the gib or bent it bent & weather to end the day

Tuesday August the 3

Remark on Board Tuesday August the 3
All this 24 hours very fine weather fresh winds from the SE beat up to the Island and got of bags and powder & I at night all hands on board but travelling four our Ylervate to end the day with light wind

Wednesday August the 4 18:41

Remark on Board Wednesday August the 4
All this 24 hours very fine weather all sail set beating toward the Island to cap up but a very strong current sent in two boats & wadding got of six loads or wood and sun vegetables several boats from the shore

Thursday August the 5

Remark on Board Thursday August the 5
All these 24 hours very light winds got drifted at 6 miles sent in one boat got of sun from poles one course came up to us saw one pinback latter sent fine breeze from the SE all sail set to advantage beating up to the Island to end the day

Friday August the 6

Remark on Board Friday August the 6
All these 24 hours very fine weather all sail set got in to the Island sent in one boat & got a few things at night all hands on board & beyond the yards to the Westward & we are bound to end the Elvise in company with us latter 1:00 long

Saturday August the 7

Remark on Board Saturday August the 7
All these 24 hours very fine weather all sail set to advantage very light winds from the SE steering West the People Implied in making Shungorn and got the change of gun and sent at nothing in the boat the ship arrived to end the day with very light winds from all parts or the compass latter long
