Took a Bow Head

at three A.M. anchored
in 7 1/2 fathoms - got under
way again at 6.30 A.M.
in sight all whaling crew
got two whales Kahluk 2
Jenette 1 Belvedere 1 and
I lowered my Boat at-
on P.M. at 4 waist-boat
struck cut-in and set-
the watch at 8 P.M.
and shall start the work
as soon as get bone
steamed away.
