SUNDAY OCT 11th

These 24 Hours light wind and pleasant
this day being Sunday there is now work
going on we exchanged Colours with and
English Barge this night at Sun
set pulled the mainsail and the
light sail 3 sails in sight so
ends these 24 Hours this day
steaming full and by heading

MONDAY OCT 12th

These 24 Hours light wind
and variable this morning
at daylight made all sail
to day hoisted out for water
to day 5 sails in sight
this night at sunset took
the light sails 4 ends
these 24 Hours

TUESDAY OCT 13th

These 24 Hours strong wind
and squally with rain to day
watch employed in ship duty
this afternoon at 10 clock took
in the light sails and doubled
reefed the topsails and at 3
clock made all sail to day
3 sails in sight so ends

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WEDNESDAY OCT 14th

These 24 Hours wind squally
with rain this morning at daylight
called all hands and washed
off this afternoon took in the
light sails watch employed
in ship duty to day 1 sail
in sight so ends these
24 Hours

LON 23.31

THURSDAY OCT 15th

Here part of this day strong wind
and squally with rain latter part
pleasant this morning called all
hands and washed off this after-
noon sent down by sail to fit
the rigging so ends these 24
Hours

Course full and by

LON 22.17

FRIDAY OCT 16th

Here part of this day strong wind
and squally latter part pleasant
this night sent up the spanke-
gaft this morning at daylight
called all hands and washed
off to day hoisted out fore water
to day heading SSW to day one
sail in sight this afternoon
saw a Breeze so ends these
24 Hours
