THE BRIG THO^W WINSLOW
Nov 1846

MONDAY Nov 9th

These 24 Hours Strong Wind
and cloudy this morning Called
all hands and made Sail
and washed off to day spoke
the 1st Brig Sloop of Warhorne
Capt Linscott 3 months out
with 80 lbs 2 more Sail in
sight 20 ends these 24 Hours
Bore part of the day came W
latter part standing by the Wind

TUESDAY Nov 10th

These 24 Hours Strong Wind
and cloudy this morning Called
all hands and made Sail
and washed off to day spoke
out for water and grain
4 Sails in sight to night
then Shortened Sail 20 ends
these 24 Hours to day standing
by the Wind

WEDNESDAY Nov 11th

These 24 Hours Strong Wind and
cloudy with rain this morning
Called all hands and made Sail
and washed off to day raised
A spout of water to be A Pump
Back 2 Sails in sight 20
ends these 24 Hours standing by the
Wind

Wind NE LAT 17.52 LONG 35.03

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THURSDAY Nov 12th

These 24 Hours equally with rain
this morning Called all hands
and washed off to day spoke
the Brig Sloop of Warhorne
Capt Linscott 4 months out 70 lbs
which he sent home to day we are
gaming standing by the Wind

These 24 light Winds and rainless
this morning Called all hands and
washed off to day spoke and gamed
again with the Forrest to day is very
rainy 20 ends these 24 Hours
standing by the Wind

These 24 Hours Strong Wind
with rain this morning Called
all hands and washed off
this fore noon at last up the
fore and main masts and at
sunset put the fore Sail on
start in sight 20 ends these
