WEDNESDAY Nov 18th
These 24 Hours commences with
light breeze and pleasant
this morning called all hands
and washed off this morning
boke out for Bruce to day
employed in putting down the
main rigging to day sails
beaches proved to be Yampew
2 sails in sight do ends
these 24 Hours Maneuvering by
the Wind Wind NNE

THURSDAY Nov 19th
These 24 Hours strong breeze
and pleasant this morning
called all hands and made
Sail and washed off to day
watch employed in ship duty
to night 2 sails in sight do
ends these 24 Hours one sail
in sight Maneuvering by the
Wind Wind NNE
LAT 15.33
LONG 35.50

FRIDAY Nov 20th
These 24 Hours commences with strong
breeze this morning called all hands
and made Sail and washed off this day
at 12 o'clock raised Sperm Whales toward
the boats and give chase but did not
get fast and at 2 o'clock came on
board on Sail in sight Maneuvering by
the Wind Wind NNE LAT 15.41 LONG 36.11
