FRIDAY JAN 15th

This day light wind and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off to day took out fore water. So ends this day Steaming by the wind

SATURDAY JAN 16th

This day light wind and pleasant this morning called all hands and washed off all hands employed in washing and mending. So ends this day Steaming by the wind

SUNDAY JAN 17th

This day light wind and pleasant this morning called all hands and washed off 2 sails in sight. So ends this day Steaming by the wind

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MONDAY JAN 18th

First part of this day light wind and pleasant latter part strong wind this morning called all hands and washed off this morning sent down the foretop sail to mend and this afternoon sent it up again. So ends this day Steaming by the wind

LONG 22.33

TUESDAY JAN 19th

This day light wind and pleasant this morning called all hands and washed off watch employed in ship duty. So ends this day Steaming by the wind
Heading E. S. E.
Wind NE.

WEDNESDAY JAN 20th

This day light wind and pleasant this morning called all hands and washed off watch employed in ship duty & sails in sight. So ends this day. Two night shortened sail course E. B. N. to day took out for molasses. Wind NW
LAT 32.15
LONG 19.00

THURSDAY JAN 21st

This day strong wind and squally this morning called all hands and washed off and after breakfast made sail to day took out for water and Breast watch employed in felling the fore and main topsail masts and making spinnaker to night shortened sail. So ends this day course E. B. N. Wind S. S. W. LAT 31.11 LONG 17.04
