JAN 1847

SATURDAY JAN 30th

This day light wind and smooth
this morning called hands and washed
dail and washed off at 1^o clock
sailed Yarmouth packets and toward the
boats and give chase but did not fast
the Starboard boat started but the
whole was to far off get on board at
9^o clock and hoisted up the boats

SUNDAY JAN 31st (Sund)

This day light wind and smooth
with calm this morning called
all hands and washed off
No sight this day LAT 21.16
LONG 12.13

MONDAY FEB 1st (Sund)

This day light wind and pleasant
this morning called all hands and
washed off this morning broke out
for Broad and water out of the way
sailed employed in ship duty. So ends
this day

This day light wind and pleasant this day
morning called all hands and washed off
sailed employed in ship duty to day
saw Grampuses and So ends this day

WEDNESDAY FEB 3rd (a)

This day light wind and pleasant this
morning called all hands and washed
off to day watch employed in sitting
up the head rigging. So ends this
day

THURSDAY FEB 4th (H)

This day light wind and pleasant
this morning called all hands and
washed off watch employed in ship
duty. So ends this day Course S.W.
Wind WBS

LAT 21.26
LONG 8.40

FRIDAY FEB 5th (H)

This day light wind and pleasant
this morning called all hands and washed
off and at 6^o clock saw Black Fish haul
the boats and gave chase and the Starboard
boat struck and the line got fast and drew
the iron and at 8 came on board and
hoisted up the boats and at 1 the west
boat hauled but did not get fast after 4 broke
out for water. So ends this day
