SATURDAY FEB 6th

This day light Wind and pleasant
this morning Catted all hands and washed
of all hands employed in washing and
mending this day. Dredg. Willers and
Grampers. Do ends this day. Course E.S.E.
Wind W

SUNDAY FEB 7th

Fore part of this day Calm latter
part moderate Wind. this morning
Catted all hands and washed off
New Grampers and Do ends this
day. Course E.S.E.
Wind N.E.
LAT 27.36
LONG 6.01

MONDAY FEB 8th

This day moderate Wind and
pleasant this morning Catted all hands
and washed off muckle employed in
Ship duty. Do ends this day.
Course E.S.E.
Wind N.E.
LAT 27.46
LONG 5.28

TUESDAY FEB 9th

This day moderate Wind and pleasant
this morning Catted all hands and
washed off to day sent down the foretopgum
and gaid to fit the rigging and mend the sail
got it fith and sent it up again. Do ends this day
Course E. Wind W.S.W. LAT 27.26 LONG 3.10

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WEDNESDAY FEB 10th

This day light Wind and pleasant
this morning Catted all hands and
washed off to day watch employed
in setting up the bunkstays fore
and aft. Do ends this day.
Course E.N.E.
Wind N.W.
LAT 26.37
LONG 2.51

THURSDAY FEB 11th

Fore part of this day light Wind and
pleasant latter part squally with rain
being fresh this morning Catted all
hands and washed off at 12 o'clock
took 2 ships in the topsails and put on
the mainsail and gill and at sunset
put on the fore topsail and foresail and cum-
sac on the larboard tack under close
reef maintopsail. Do ends this day.
Course N.W. by E.
Wind S.
LAT 26.00
LONG 1.00

FRIDAY FEB 12th

This day Strong Wind and cloudy
this morning Catted all hands and
washed off to day took out for
provision and sent in the old gill and
put out the new gill in the morning
set the foretopmast and the foresail and
at 11 o'clock shook the tops out and
at sunset Shortened Unit. Do ends this
day. Course N.E. by E. Wind S. LAT 25.40 LONG 2.11
