Remarks Sunday April 15th
 Here part of this day commences with strong wind from N.E. at 6 A.M. took in the Studding Sail at 7 A.M. took in the flying jib and maintop gallant. Light breeze part more moderate at 1 P.M. set the light sails. We ends this day Course N. by E. 1/2 N.

Remarks Monday April 16th
 Here part of this day commences with strong wind from N.E. at 4 A.M. took in the Studding Sail and flying jib at 5. Set the main again. Light rain latter part pleasant N. by E. Set the fore-top gallant. Course N. by E. 1/2 N. We ends this day

Remarks Tuesday April 17th
 Here part of this day commences with strong wind from N.E. but pleasant. Mistake part took in the fore-top gallant. Sails and 8 A.M. broke out for water and sail in light. Latter part light rain. Course N. by E. We ends this day Lat 13. 25 Long 51. 15

Remarks Wednesday April 18th
 Here part of this day commences with strong wind from N.E. this morning broke out for Broad Middle part at 3 P.M. saw Black fish latter part took in the 10. P.M. Studding Sail Course N. by E. 1/2 N. Lat Long

Here part of this day commences with strong wind from the N.E. at 6 A.M. set the Studding Sail. Mistake part the sails, the flying jib. We ends this day Course N. by E. 1/2 N. Lat Long

Remarks Friday May 1st
 Here part of this day commences with moderate wind from N.E. and pleasant. Mistake part at 2 part 5 set the fore-top gallant. Sails and at 1 P.M. took in the this after noon broke out for previous Course N. by E. 1/2 N. We ends this day Lat Long

Remarks Saturday May 2nd
 Here part of this day commences with strong wind from the N.E. at 5 A.M. raised the distance of that Indies. Mistake part at 3 P.M. course to anchor in the Island of Dominica. 4 day saw 5 ships latter part squally with light rain. We ends this day Lat Long

Remarks Sunday May 3rd
 Here part of this day commences with light wind and weather this morning at daylight pulled all hands and bore up the anchor and dropped up the bay. Mistake part at 11 A.M. raised the fore-top gallant one but not from the fore-top but did not get fast. Latter part squally with light rain. We ends this day at 8 A.M. Studding Sail Lat Long

Remarks Monday May 4th
 Here part of this day commences with squally weather with rain this morning pulled all hands and worked at 8 A.M. watch. Latter part went on shore. Mistake part watch employed in filling water. We ends this day
