Remarks Tuesday May 5th
Fore part of this day commenced with
breeze with rain this morning called all
hands and got off a raft of water. Midst
post more pleasant the foreward watch
went on shore at 8 AM the watch on
board employed in stowing down water
at 4 PM sent a raft on shore at
sundown watch came on board so ends
this day

Remarks Wednesday May 6th
Fore part of this day commenced with
light breeze and pleasant this morning at
daylight called all hands and got off
a raft of water after breakfast foreward
watch went on shore watch on board
employed in stowing down water to
day got 2 boats loads of wood at
4 PM sent a raft on shore at sundown
watch came on board so ends this
day

Remarks Thursday May 7th
This day commenced with light
breeze and pleasant first thing this morning
got off a raft and after breakfast
foreward watch went on shore and then
got off a boat load of potatoes and
then got a boat load of wood cut up
and stowed down a load of wood at
sundown watch came on board so
ends this day

Friday May 8th
This day commenced with light breeze
and pleasant this morning called all
hands and on the boat for wood after
breakfast the foreward watch went on shore
watch on board employed in stowing down
water at 4 PM sent a raft on shore to
day the Brig Genl of Providence came
in about one year out with 250 of oil
at sundown watch came off so ends
this day

This day commenced with light breeze and
pleasant this morning called all hands
and got off a raft after breakfast the
foreward watch went on shore watch on
board employed painting ship at sundown
watch came off so ends this day

Remarks Sunday May 10th
This day commenced with light breeze
and pleasant this morning after
breakfast the foreward watch went
on shore this morning at sunrise the
Midford started at sundown the
watch came off so ends this day

Remarks Monday May 11th
This day commenced with light breeze and
rain this morning got off a boat of wood at
10 AM the Brig Montic of Chittenden 16 with out
with 650 came in at 12 PM weighed anchor
and put to sea at sundown foreward watch
came off so ends this day
