midst part more pleasant & at 10 A.M. set the foresail and
left of A. A. H. latter part squally with light
rain at sunset furl the foresail to end this
day

at 1 P.M. took out for provisions and kept off
A. H. latter part thick with light rain
to end this day

and latter part more pleasant water employed

that we have been steering was N. A. H.
to end this day
