These 24 hours commenced and ended with light wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made shift and washed off at 8 A.M. sent down the main-top sail to mend and at 4 P.M. sent it up again at sunset shortened shift.

Remarks Tuesday May 26th

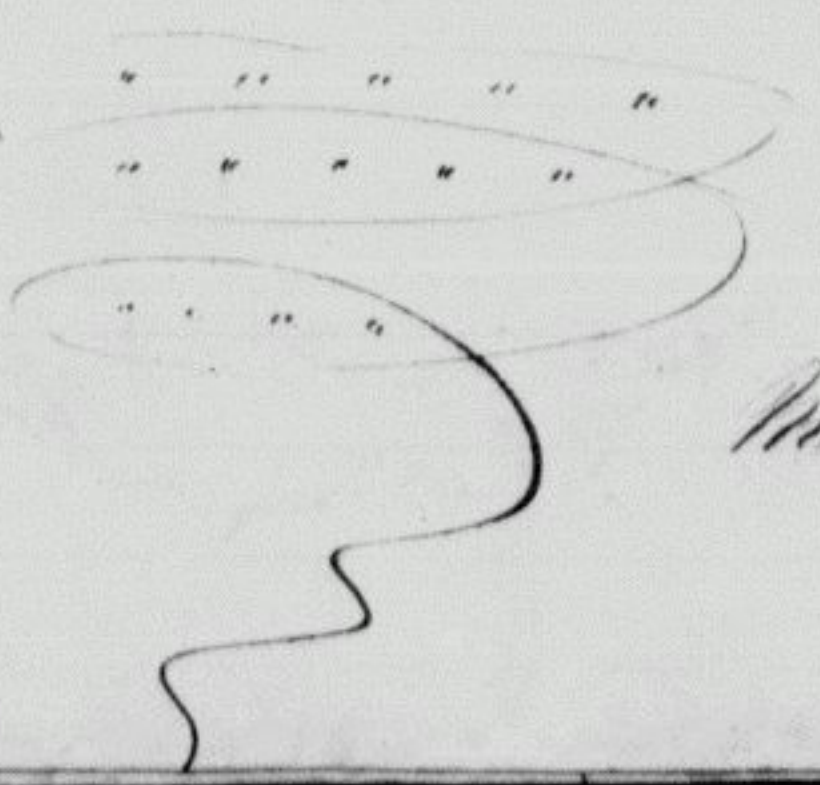
These 24 hours commenced and ended with light wind and calm from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made shift and washed off at 8 A.M. sent down the fore-top to mend and at 3 P.M. sent it up again at sunset shortened shift put the main-top sail and took 2 reefs in the fore-top sail.

These 24 hours commenced and ended with light wind and calm from the N.E. by A. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made shift and washed off watches employed in ship's duty and shift in sight at sunset shortened shift put the fore-top sail and took 2 reefs in the main-topping N. by A. He ended this day.

Remarks On Board May 1847

Thursday May 28th

These 24 hours commenced and ended with light wind from the N.E. and pleasant at daylight called all hands and made shift and washed off watches employed in ship's duty at 10 A.M. lowered the fore-top sheet for a bottle at sunset shortened shift put the fore-top sail and took 2 reefs in the main and kept to the wind steering N. by W. throughout the day.

Remarks Friday May 29th

These 24 hours commenced with strong wind from the N. by A. and pleasant at daylight called all hands and made shift and washed off watches employed in ship's duty to dig holes out for water at sunset shortened shift put the fore-top sail and what reefed the main-fore part of this day steering N. by A. better part steering by the wind He ended this day 3 boats in sight Lat 30° 10' N. Long 110° 10' W.

Remarks Saturday May 30th

Fore part of this day commenced with strong wind from the N. by A. and squally with rain middle part more pleasant this morning called all hands and made shift set the fore-top sail double reefed and shocked and reefed out of the main and set the main-top sail and gave watch employed in ship's duty at sunset shortened shift put the fore-top sail and what reefed the main and put the main-top sail steering by the wind He ended this day.
