 The part of this day commenced with moderate
 wind from the N.E. with rain this morning called
 all hands and made shift and washed off middle
 part the same watch employed in ship duty
 latter part strong wind with rain at
 sunset shortened shift. At night reefed the main
 topsail and put the fore. Morning to the end
 this day

 This day commenced with strong winds from
 the N.E. with thick weather this morning called
 all hands and made shift set the foretopsail
 and shook our rig out of the main and shift
 in sight. latter part the same to night raising
 the reefed topsail. Morning to the end this

 This day
 The part of this day commenced with squally wind
 with rain from the N.E. at 2 o'clock
 set the fore and put the fore & shift in sight
 at daylight called all hands and made shift
 fore and washed off middle part more pleasant
 at 4 set the foretopsail and set foremast. Morning
 to the wind the end this day

 wind from the E.N.E. and pleasant this
 morning called all hands and made shift
 and washed off one shift in sight watch
 employed in ship duty at sunset shortened
 shift. Morning to the wind the end this

 This day commenced and ended with light wind
 from the E.N.E. and pleasant this morning called
 all hands and made shift and washed off to
 day took out for water and provision at 4 o'clock
 raised black fish lowered the boat but did not
 get fast at sunset shortened shift. Morning
 to the end this day

 wind and rain at daylight called all hands
 and made shift and washed off middle and
 latter pleasant watch employed in ship duty
 wind S.W. at sunset shortened shift
 Morning to the end this day

 This day commenced and ended with moderate wind
 from the E. and pleasant at daylight called
 all hands and made shift and washed off
 watch employed in ship duty at sunset shortened
 shift. Morning to the end this day

 The part of this day commenced with strong wind
 from the E. at daylight called all hands and
 made shift and washed off one shift in sight
 middle part and latter part the same to day took
 in the flying jib and main topgallant sail and at 3
 o'clock reefed the topsails at sunset shortened shift put
 the foretopsail and main sail and jib. Morning
 to the end this day
