Remarks Tuesday June 16th
This day commences and ends with strong wind from the N.E. W. and pleasant this morning called all hands and set the foretop sail with reef and the gill and mainsail and washed off the deck and set for head at sunset shortened sail full the foretop sail and mainsail and gill showing N.E. by E.

Remarks Wednesday June 17th
This day commences and ends with light winds from the N.E. W. and pleasant at daylight called all hands and made sail and washed off the deck employed in ship duty at sunset shortened sail showing by the wind to end this day

Remarks Thursday June 18th
This day commences and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. W. and pleasant at daylight called all hands and made sail and washed off the deck employed in watching down the fore rigging at 6 P.M. spoke the ship from Adams of Providence 2 months out from at sunset shortened sail showing by the wind to end this day

Remarks Friday June 19th
This day commences and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. W. and pleasant at daylight called all hands and made sail and washed off the deck broke out for water and meat from gunpowder at sunset shortened sail for part of the way showing E.S.E. better part E.N.E.

This day commences and ends with strong winds and squally with rain from the N.E. W. this morning called all hands and made sail with the foretop sail and set mainsail and at 10 A.M. close reefed the foretop sail and paid the foretop sail and main on sail in sight showing by the wind to end this day

Remarks Sunday June 21st
This day commences and ends with strong wind from the N.E. W. and pleasant this morning called all hands and set the foretop sail double reefed and set the mainsail at 1 P.M. set shake in reefed out of the main top sail at sunset shortened sail full the foretop sail and mainsail showing by the wind to end this day
