Remarks Wednesday June 24th
 Fore part of this day commences with light
 breeze squally with light rain middle and latter
 part pleasant at daylight called all hands and
 made all suit and washed off to day saw five
 and possessed 2 birds in sight at 5 P.M. the
 harbour boat went on board off Portique big
 for Brazil bound to Lisbon at sunset shortened
 sail steering by the wind to end this day
 Lat
 Long

Remarks Thursday June 25th
 This day commences and ends with light wind
 from the N.E. and pleasant at daylight
 called all hands and made suit and washed
 off 2 birds in sight to day took out for
 bread at sunset shortened sail steering E. by N.
 to end this day
 Lat

Remarks Friday June 26th
 Fore part of this day commences with light wind
 and pleasant middle part strong rather squally
 with light rain from the N.E. at daylight
 called all hands and made suit and washed
 off at 1 P.M. raised black fish towards the boats
 and the west boat got fast but the crew drove
 at 3 P.M. spoke the big British frigate of
 Norfolk bound to Norfolk at sunset shortened
 sail steering E. by N. at sunset left to the
 wind to end this day
 Lat

Remarks Saturday June 27th
 This day commences and ends with strong wind
 and squally this morning called all hands and
 washed off this day lying to at 4 P.M. shot the
 parrot and bird to end this day
 Lat
 Long

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Remarks Sunday June 28th
 This day commences and ends with strong wind from
 E. by N. and pleasant this morning called all
 hands made suit and washed off to day and
 sail in sight at 10 A.M. raised fishbake coffee
 breakfast kept off E. at sunset shortened sail
 and left to the wind to end this day
 Lat
 Long

Remarks Monday June 29th
 This day commences and ends with light winds
 from the N.E. and pleasant this morning
 called all hands and made suit and washed off
 to day dined out the night at sunset shortened
 sail steering E. at sunset left to the
 wind to end this day
 Lat

Remarks Tuesday June 30th
 Remarks This day commences and ends with light
 wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning
 called all hands and made suit and washed off
 this day got 4 porpoise water employed in ship
 duty at 6 P.M. spoke the big British frigate of
 Norfolk bound to Norfolk at 5 P.M. raised
 the harbour boat but did not get fast at sunset
 shortened sail steering by the wind to end
 this day

 the N.E. this morning called all hands and
 made suit and washed off watch employed in ship
 duty at 6 P.M. the big boat came on board
 and at sunset shortened sail steering by
