Remarks Sunday July 10th
This day commences and ends with strong wind from the N.E. and squally with rain this morning called all hands and washed off and then put off E by S at 11 AM struck out the reefs and set the mainsail. Watch employed in ship duty one suit in light this night commences standing half watches to end this day

This day commences and ends with strong wind from the N.E. and squally with light rain this day exchanged roles with a English Stained watch employed in ship duty standing E by N to end this day

This day commences and ends with strong wind and squally with thick water at 8 AM made the land and at 10 AM reefed the topsails and strong E strong E these the day and then the night hazing of and on to end this day

This day commences and ends with light wind and squally this day at 4 PM the boat went on shore at 5 PM 3 sails in light on is the ship fired then and the Bangor Emerald boat of New Bedford 2 minutes out the ship is clear the Bangor has got 2 whales at dusk the boat came off to end this day
