

Remarks On Board July 1848

Remarks Monday July 18th
This day commences and ends with strong
wind from the N.W. and thick weather
this morning the boat on shore at 12 noon
came off at 2 PM spoke the ship John of
New Bedford one month out ahead at 3 PM
fell away and let the island at 4 PM sailed
the ship with three sails in sight to end
this day N.E. by E. S. S. Lat

Remarks Tuesday July 19th
This day commences with strong wind from the
N.W. and finally at 1 PM raised the land
at sunset backed ship and stood out from
land bearing N.W. to end this day
Lat

Remarks Wednesday July 21st
This day commences and ends with strong
wind and pleasant this day trying of iron
on at 10 AM to day spoke the barque Phoenix
of New Bedford 22 days out ahead this day got
off 12 casks of water but one on shore on ship
duty to end this day Lat

Remarks Thursday July 22nd
This day commences and ends with strong wind
and pleasant this day one boat came on shore on
ship duty the rest employed in stowing down water
this day spoke the ship John and Edwards of
New Bedford 2 months with S. S. this afternoon made
sail and stood out from the land bearing N.W.
wind N.W. to end this day Lat

Remarks Friday July 23rd
This day commences and ends with strong wind from
the N.W. and pleasant water employed in ship duty
bearing by the wind to day saw grampiers to end this
day Lat

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Remarks Saturday July 24th
This day commences and ends with light wind from
the E.S. by E. and pleasant this day 2 sails in
sight water employed in ship duty bearing
N.W. to end this day Lat

Remarks Sunday July 25th
This day commences and ends with light wind
from the N.W. and pleasant this day saw
grampiers bearing N.W. by W. to end
this day Lat

Remarks Monday July 26th
This day commences and ends with light wind
and variable and pleasant this day sent down
the main top sail and sent it up fore and fast
the old main top sail left bearing N.W. to
end this day Lat

Remarks Tuesday July 27th
This day commences and ends with light wind
and variable thick weather water employed in ridding
up the sail fore top sail to end this day
Lat

Remarks Wednesday July 28th
This day commences and ends with light wind
this at 2 PM the captain went on board of the barque
of Boston to take breakfast at 11 AM came
on board water employed in ship duty to end
this day 3 sails in sight Lat

Remarks Thursday July 29th
Fore part of this day commences with light
wind from the N.W. and pleasant middle
part and latter strong part part of the day bearing
N. better part N.W. to end this day
Lat
