Remarks Friday July 30th
This day commenced and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant weather part light wind watch employed in ship's duty one sail in sight steering E.N.E. course W.N.W. so ends this day

Remarks Saturday July 31st
This day commenced and ends with strong wind from the N.E. and pleasant 2 sails in sight to make out for water to night shortened sail and commenced standing by once over N.E. a day saw beaches so ends this day

Remarks Sunday August 1st
For part of this day commenced with strong wind from the N.E. and pleasant middle and latter moderate 3 sails in sight to day the helmsman put and we had to make out the foretopmast heads up the water and make it after to bring the bow out so to work over the bow for part of the day steering N.W. at 12⁰⁰ shifted to the wind at sunset shortened sail so ends this day the night spoke 2 English barges

Remarks Monday August 2nd
This day commenced and ends with strong wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off watch employed in ship's duty 3 sails in sight steering by the wind so ends this day

This day commenced and ends with strong wind from the E.N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off 7 sails in sight at 2⁰⁰ lowered for blackfish but did not get fast steering by the wind so ends this day

Remarks Wednesday August 4th
This day commenced and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off watch employed in ship's duty to night at 1⁰⁰ lowered for blackfish but did not get fast at sunset shortened sail steering by the wind so ends this day

Remarks Thursday August 5th
For part of this day moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off middle and latter strong wind and squally at 3⁰⁰ reefed topsail and furled the mainsail at sunset furled the foresail at 4⁰⁰ saw blackfish but did not lower so ends this day steering by the wind

Remarks Friday August 6th
This day commenced and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off watch employed in ship's duty at sunset shortened sail steering by the wind so ends this day the day spoke the Sea Island 3 months out of steam

This day commenced and ends with moderate wind from the N.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off 3 sails in sight watch employed in ship's duty steering by the wind at sunset shortened sail so ends this day

This day commenced and ends with light wind S.E. and pleasant this morning called all hands and made sail and washed off at 2⁰⁰ raised sperm whale toward the Meboat and saw whale in company with the Spain's boat at 3⁰⁰ came on board at sunset the Spain's and jammed with her at sunset shortened sail steering by the wind so ends this day
