Remarks Friday August 20th
This day commences and ends with light
breeze and variable this morning called all
hands and made sail and worked off watch
employed in ship duty & sails in light at sunset
Shut down sail stowed by the time to end
this day
Lat

Remarks Saturday August 21st
This day commences and ends with strong
wind and squally from the N.E. this morning
called all hands and made sail and worked
off 4 sails in light watch employed in ship
duty at sunset shut down sail and stowed the
downs this morning left off 4 at sunset left
to be made this day
Lat

Remarks Sunday August 22nd
This day commences and ends with strong wind
with light rain this morning called all hands and
made sail and worked off 4 sails in light
watch by the time to end this day
Lat
Long

Remarks Monday August 23rd
This day commences and ends with light
breeze and calm this morning called all hands
and made sail and worked off watch employed
in ship duty & sails in light wind N.E.
Shut down by the time at sunset stowed sail
to end this day

Remarks Tuesday August 24th
This day commences and ends with light breeze
and pleasant this morning called all hands and
made sail and worked off watch employed in ship duty
during the rigging to night commenced stowing the
watches & sail in light to end this day

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Remarks Wednesday August 25th
This day commences and ends with strong wind
from the N.W. by N. watch employed in ship duty
at 2 P.M. before the topsail and furl the 4th
Heaving N.W. by N. to end this day
Lat

Remarks Thursday August 26th
This day commences and ends with light breeze
from the N.E. and pleasant this morning employed in
filling ship first for top gallant sail and stowing sail
under W by N & N to end this day
Lat

Remarks Friday August 27th
This day commences and ends with moderate wind
from the E and fine weather the watch employed
in the rigging and filling the foremast stowed
this day Heaving W by N
Latitude 33.15
Longitude 54.12

Saturday 28th
Commences with moderate wind from the E and
fine weather Heaving W. N. E. under full sail
middle and latter part the same all hands
employed in taring down the rigging to end this
day
Latitude 33.20
Longitude 54.10

Sunday 29th
Commences with moderate wind from the E and fine
weather Heaving W. N. E. under full sail watch employed
in ship duty to end this day
at 3 P.M. raised spar to make
hoist the topsail but did not get
Lat
