Commenced with gentle breeze & squalls with rain
Hail & thin head SW to NW wind shifted to NW
Through the moderate breeze head SW to NW
At 4 AM took a look from the head NW
Left port about 10 AM from the head NW
Visible sail of a ship to the SW bound West

Through the light moderate set main
sail

Left port set double top sails
