Commenced with hard gale from ESE with
powerful squalls head S.W.B. (last three) Main
top sail & storm sail set
Left port strong gale near 11 AM Sun observed
Long Lat 30-22

Remarks on Sunday March 9
Commenced with hard gale from ESE with
head squalls at 4 PM took in main top sail
Laz lines Mizzen stay sail set down main
top of mast
Through the night hard winds with a heavy
sea at 10 PM ship set sail stone & boats on
deck
Left port more moderate set down top sail
Storm sail Long Lat 29 30 Long East 54-52

Remarks on Monday March 10
Commenced with strong breeze from ESE with
squalls at 4 PM took in the top
at 5 PM set back fore sail & main top sail
head at 10 PM set (last three) fore & main top sails
Left port light breeze at 10 AM took to the SW wind
inclining to the southward Long Lat 34-13
Long East 59-45

Remarks on Tuesday March 11
Commenced with gentle squalls double drift
the top sail head S.W. then S.W. to S.W. wind
Moderate at 11 AM took in the main top sail
Through the night strong breeze from ESE head
at 11 PM double drift top sails &
Left port brisk breeze at 10 AM took to the SW
wind at 11 PM Long Lat 33 38
Long East 61 13
Departed at 12

Remarks on Wednesday March 12
Commenced with strong breeze from ESE with
head S.W.B. double drift top sail set
Through the night hard winds at 2 AM near
S.W.
Left port moderate breeze head S.W.B. wind
S.W. and a Man of War being sighted to the South
where it is called Long Lat 33-38
Long East 62 44

Commenced with gentle breeze all sail set head
S.W. wind
Left port brisk breeze from ESE head squalls with
double drift Long Lat 30-00
Long East 63-00

Commenced with gentle breeze from ESE with
squalls all sail set at 6 PM double drift
the top sail took to the S.W. at 2 PM took
to S.W. main top sail
Left port moderate all sail set head to the
Southward Long Lat 49-01
