

Thursday August 15th 1759
All this day fresh breezes from
the N.E. Steering S by E and
pleasant weather. Nothing in
sight at all. Lat 21.16. Long
By Chron. 26.42 By Lunar 26.05

Friday 16th
First part of this day fresh wind
from the N.E. Middle part
light breezes from the S. and
pleasant weather. Saw a
Bark Towing 4 Sails. Latter
part light winds and Raining
heading to the South.
Lat 19.09. Long 25.55. W

Saturday 17th
First part light breezes from
the S.E. Steering S by E sails
in sight. at 8 o'clock Tacked Ship
and stood to the Eastward. Latter
part of this day light breezes and
pleasant. Lat 17.23 Long 25.51.

Sunday 18th
First part light breezes from the S.E.
Steering S.E. at 4 o'clock Made St. Anthony
4 points off our weather Bore 30 Miles
Distance. 7 Sails in sight. All Bore
to the South. At Noon saw
a school of Black fish comers for
them, but got nothing. Latter part
fresh breezes from the S.E. and
clear weather.

Monday 19th of August
First part of this day light breezes from
the S.E. Steering S by E and pleasant
weather. Middle part wind from the
N.E. Steering to the Eastward at 10 o'clock
P.M. Made St. Yago Bearing S.S. 44 saw a school
of Black comers for them but got nothing.
At sundown the land 4 miles off
Bore ship and stood off shore.
The rest part of the night standing off
and on the west side of the Island.

Tuesday 20th
First part fresh breezes from the
N.E. At sunrise run down to the
Saw of the Island and there saw
untill Noon saw a village in
shore took Porto Praya left went
on shore but did not land
came on Board at 3 o'clock stood
around to the Southward. Latter
part of this day light breezes
from the S.E. saw a ship sailing
at anchor and a Schooner
standing off and on the Town
Porto Praya saw a great many
Porpoises &c. At 1/2 past 4 o'clock got an
Altitude and Made Long 23.33 by Sun 2.53 from
the Chron. 1 hour 10 min. after Alt. Add
The At 8 o'clock Past 8 bore Topsy's schooner
The remainder of the night stood
off and on the East side of the Island
