 Light breezes from the
 W. & N. steering steering
 to the S. saw a few
 Black fish. And 5 or 6 sails
 all bound to the South with
 a head wind latter part
 of the day rather cloudy
 Weather Lat 35° Long 15.10

September Sunday 1st of September
 All this day light winds
 from the SSW and SSW
 steering on the wind to the
 W. 4 sails in sight saw a few
 black and some black fish porpoises
 etc. 1 French ship latter part cloudy
 Lat 3.10. N Long 15.24

Monday 2nd
 First part of this day light winds
 from the SSW steering on the
 wind to the west. And thick
 rainy weather Middle & latter part
 much the same as the first
 No observation this day

Tuesday 3rd
 The first part of this day
 light breezes and thick mist.
 latter part clear weather
 and a light breeze from
 the SSW steering SSW and
 W. & N. 2 sails in sight
 A steamer Lat 2.07 Long 17.45
 saw a few cow fish
 in the evening

September 4th 1839
 All this day light breezes from
 the SSW steering SSW and
 pleasant weather 1 sail in
 sight Lat 1.10 North Long 18.55
 Thursday 5th
 Light breezes from the SSW
 steering SSW and pleasant
 weather 1 sail steamer
 Lat 7. miles South
 Long 21.14

Friday 6th
 Fine S. Trades and pleasant weather
 A noon saw a school of Black
 fish lowered Boats struck 2
 Black fish. And 1 cow fish
 saved 1 Black fish. And the
 cow fish latter part fish
 breezes from the S. steering
 SSW 1 sail in sight off
 our lee quarter. Lat 2.07 Long 22.40

Saturday 7th
 All this Day fresh breezes
 from the S. steering SSW
 and pleasant weather saw
 plenty of Porpoises. And
 1 sail off our lee quarter
 Lat 3.55 Long 23.35 W

Sunday 8th
 First part of this day pleasant
 weather and a strong
 breeze from the S. steering
 SSW. latter part storm
 winds steering SSW under
 D. & T. Lat 4.20 Long 24.40
