All this day strong breezes from
the SE Steering SSW under
single reefed topsails. Clear weather.
Nothing in sight Lat 8.30 Long 26.10

Wednesday 11th
First part of this day light
breezes from the SE by E and
rain squalls. Towed the keel out of
topsails Steering S by N Middle
and latter part fresh breezes and
clear weather At 4 o'clock past
A Brig Steering N. N. E. Lat 10.17 Long 26.51 W.

Thursday 12th
First part of this day fresh breezes
from the SE Steering S under all
sails. 1 sail in sight. Middle
part light breezes latter part strong
breezes took in the S by E and
Mizen S. J. Kant sail. Bent the
Fore Spencer. Lat 12.31 Long 27.09

Friday 13th
Strong S. S. S. at 4 in the morning
set the Mizen S. and S by E
Remainder part of the fresh
winds and pleasant weather
2 sails in sight Steering S
Lat 14.30 Long by Chron 27.17
by Lunar 27.08

Saturday September 14th 1839
Fresh S. S. S. and pleasant weather
1 sail in sight. Saw 4 Ships Back
Lat 16.40
Steering S. W. Long by Chron 28.00

First part of this day strong breezes
from the S. S. E. and pleasant
weather. Steering S. W. 1 sail
in sight. A Steamer lat by Chron 19.38
Middle and latter Long by Chron 28.28
part of this day By Sun 28.31
fine winds, and pleasant

from the N. N. E. Steering S. W.
And heavy rain and squalls
squalls. Middle and latter part
strong breezes and heavy squalls
