

Friday October 18th 1839

First part of this day strong breezes from the S.W. and cloudy weather. At 1 P.M. Top sails steering to the W. Middle and latter part made all sail. Saw two Sulphur Bottoms. This day ends with calm and pleasant weather.

Lat 34° 51' Long 28° 55' West
At 7 O'clock Angle R the Top sails

Saturday 19th First part of this day light breezes from the N. steering South and pleasant weather. Latter part steering S.W. Saw 1 sail spoke in the Marcus Dag Harbor 65 Bbs Sparrow - Saw 2 finbacks. Lat 35 10 Long 29 21

Sunday 20th All this day a gail of wind from the N. and thick Rainy weather. at 7 O'clock A.M. wore ship heading N by N. at 1 P.M. wore again heading E.N.E. At 6 P.M. wore ship again to the West. the wind had around West heading S.S.W.

Lat 35 42 Long 28 56

Monday 21st First part of this Day light winds from the W. and Rainy, Middle and latter parts light breezes and pleasant steering to the S and E. Saw several finbacks. At 4 O'clock W. Lat 36 14 Long 28 17

Tuesday 22nd All this Day strong breezes from the E. First part steering E.S.E. latter part W.S.W. under Top sails. Saw several finbacks. Strong breezes and pleasant weather. Lat 36 53 Long 27 32

Wednesday October 23rd 1839 Ship Triad

Saw First part of this day strong breezes from the E.S.E. steering N.W. under Top sails and Heave T.P. Latter part a gail of wind. At 4 O'clock Saw 1 Wright whale Took in sail Luff to under C.R.M.S. and Spencers. Saw 1 or 2 finbacks. Lat 36 41 Long 29 17

Thursday 24th First part of this day a gail of wind from the E.S.E. At Noon had more to the S. More ship heading E. Blowing very hard and thick Rainy weather. Latter part of this Day wind S.S.W. No Observation this Day

Friday 25th First part of this day fresh breezes from the S.W. steering S.E. At 1 O'clock A.M. wore ship heading N.W. Single Right Top sails. Saw 1 finback. Lat 36 28 Long 28 57

Saturday 26th All this day light breezes from the W.S.W. steering S. and pleasant weather. Saw 2 Wright whale lowered boats and Chast but did not get fast this day. Ends with pleasant weather. Lat 36 25 Long 28 55

Sunday 27th All this day light breezes from the N.W. At 5 O'clock A.M. Saw 2 Wright whale lowered boats and Chast but did not get fast at 11. Saw the same to the windward lowered boats and struck one. Kid him took him aboard and did him in and stowed by works.
