Friday 8th of May 1840

Throughout this Day light breezes from the SE and very pleasant weather one Watch on shore on Liberty and the other painting and getting Water

Saturday 9th of May 1840

All this Day calm and pleasant one Watch a shore on Liberty the other stowing down Water &c

Sunday 10th of May 1840

Throughout this Day light breezes and calm one watch a shore on Liberty the other on board &c

Monday 11th of May 1840

All this Day light breezes and calm pleasant got a raft of water one Watch a shore on Liberty

Tuesday 12th of May 1840

All this Day calm and pleasant one Watch on shore on Liberty the employed stowed down Water

Wednesday 13th of May 1840

Throughout this Day light breezes from the NE and clear weather one Watch on shore the other getting Wood &c Potatoes

Thursday 14th of May 1840

Throughout this Day light breezes and pleasant one Watch on shore the other on board

Friday 15th of May 1840

First and Middle parts of this Day fresh breezes from the SE and Raining Weather, latter part wind from the N and clear Weather

Saturday 16th of May 1840

First part of this Day fresh breezes from the SW, latter part calm and clear

Sunday 17th of May 1840

Throughout this Day fresh breezes from the SW and clear pleasant weather

Monday 18th of May 1840

Commenced with light breezes from the SW and clear weather At 9 O'clock AM got under way in the Bay of Islands, steering out to the NE at 6 O'clock P.M. lost sight of the Land Cape Brim Bearing SW 10 miles Distance this Day Ends with fresh breezes from the SW and clear pleasant weather.

Long at 3 O'clock by Chron 174.20 East

Tuesday 19th of May 1840

Throughout this Day light breezes from the SW and clear weather steering NE At 2 O'clock PM saw a school of Sperm Whale lowered struck and killed one took him along side, a half past 4. Look in sail for the night heading SE
