the ESE steering on the wind to the
SE pleasant Weather saw several
Fin Backs, Tuscara in sight and
one more ship, took in sail

the SE heading ESE. Pleasant Weather
with some rain Tuscara in
sight, Laying too under D.R.M.

the SE and rainy Weather heading
ENE under D.R.M. & Tuscara in
sight heading ENE Obs this Day

Saturday 11th of July 1840
Throughout this Day fresh breezes

Weather Laying too under D.R.M.
heading ENE Tuscara in sight
Obs this Day

D.R.S. Squally Weather saw nothing
of Whale kind Tuscara in sight
at 6 o'clock took in sail heading NW
